7. TCC Bylaws

With the creation of the New Bern Area MPO, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was signed by all member agencies. This MOU established the roles and responsibilities of the TAC, TCC, and the LPA.

The MOU also named voting and non-voting members of the TAC, but not of the TCC. The proposed TCC Bylaws clearly identifies voting members, and provides specific protocols on conducting virtual meetings, etc.

Chair Hodges requested his legal name be used on the signature line.

Motion: Mr. Shorter made a motion to approve the TCC Bylaws. The motion was seconded by Mr. Baumgardner and passed unanimously.

8. Public Involvement Plan (PIP)

The PIP outlines the methods and process for involving the public in the transportation planning process. The MPO reviews and updates the PIP after passage of a new federal transportation act or in advance of a MTP update. The PIP shall be reviewed at a minimum of every three years.
